



SPECIAL MEMBERS – SELECTION AND REVIEW PROCESS

1. Special membership of the NCC

1.1 Definition

1.1.1 A special member is a person, group or organization that has interest in becoming a member of the organization but does not currently have the financial means to.

1.1.2 The organization herein denoted as the Namaqualand Chamber of Commerce (NCC-NPC)

1.2 Purpose of special members

1.2.1 The purpose of special members is to identify and give NCC membership access to deserving persons, groups, or organizations who cannot afford to pay subscription fees.

1.3 Requirements of special members

1.3.1 Such a person, group, or organization must be a resident of the Namakwa District.

1.3.2 Such a person, group, or organization must be an active entrepreneur, business owner or someone in possession with an up-to-date business plan.

1.4 Application process for special members

1.4.1 A person, group, or organization interested in becoming a special member must in writing submit a motivational letter stating reasons they should be considered to become a special member.

1.4.1.1 Motivational letter must include the following:

- a) Name of person, group, or organization
- b) Business profile or Business plan
- c) Business registration documents (If available)
- d) Reasons for not being able to pay subscription fees
- e) Either an up-to-date profit and loss statement OR a 3-month certified bank statement

1.4.2 Within 30 days from submitting the motivational letter the executive committee will provide feedback on the success of the application

1.4.3 Successful applicants will have 30 days to register as a special member of the NCC, according to standard membership application process

1.4.4 Special Membership status will be reviewed on a six-monthly basis
